

THINGS THAT LAST

(II Corinthians 4:16-18) (St. John 6: 24-27)

Last: To remain in existence or operation; to continue or go on; to be inconsumable or unspent.

This word “LAST” is synonymous to the words endure, abide, bear, durable and to hold up under.

Nothing is forever, except eternity. We should not labor only for the things which perish, but more so for those things which endureth unto everlasting life which Christ shall give unto us.

Man’s appetite in these end times seems to be geared toward things that are not durable or things that will not endure, but more so on things that are not eternal and will perish.

Colossians 3:2 declares,”*set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.*”
